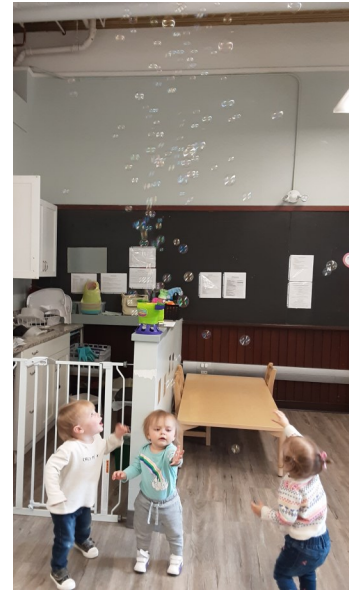

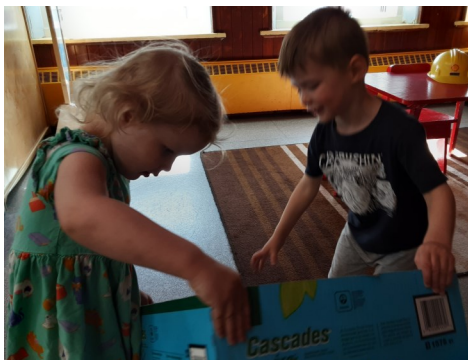


Room 2
